

Data Protection Notice and Declaration of consent

This notice provides you with information on how what kind of personal data the surgery for endoscopy Dr. Christiane Schrutka-Kölbl, Barichgasse 22, 1030 – Vienna (in further consequence: us), will process. Further, it informs you about your rights in connection with your personal data.

1. Purposes for which we process your data

For following purposes we will process your personal data (set out in Point 2):

- fulfilment of the contract regarding medical treatment
- accounting
- administration in our file of patients, medical documentation

On the one hand this data will be collected directly from you in course of your registration and thus the inclusion into our file of patients. Apart from that, we will collect a special category of personal data, namely data concerning your health in terms of article 9 subparagraph 1 of the General Data Protection Regulation (in further consequence: GDPR) in course of the medical treatment in order to fulfill our contractual duties. We expressly point out that your consented and voluntarily/freely granted provision of personal data is an indispensable condition regarding the provision of medical treatment. However, it will not be possible to enter into the contract regarding medical treatment if you do not provide your personal data.

2. Processed data categories and legal basis of the processing

We process the following categories of your personal data on the basis of your consent according to Article 6 subparagraph 1 character a GDPR:

Name, home-adress, date of birth, national social insurance number, phone number, e-mail-adress, sex. Also we will process a special category of personal data, namely data concerning your health, in course of the medical treatment in order to fulfill our contractual and legal duties.

Primary, the legal basis of the processing is your freely granted consent.

In regard of processing data concerning your health Article 9 subparagraph 2 character h GDPR constitutes a legal basis in addition to your consent. Among others, this article permits the processing of data concerning your health for the purposes of preventive or occupational medicine and the provision of health.

3. Transfer of your data

For the purposes set above, we will transfer your personal data to the following recipients:

In order to fulfil his function, our data processing manager may also encounter with your personal data.

With these persons we have special contracts concerning the protection of your personal data. In particular, these include strict obligations to confidentiality for these persons and authorities to give directives for us.

4. Retention periods

Your personal data will only be kept for as long as we reasonably consider necessary for achieving the purposes set out under Point 1 above and as is permissible under applicable law. We will, in any case, retain your personal data for as long as there are statutory retention obligations or potential legal claims are not yet time-barred.

5. Your rights in connection with your personal data

Under applicable law, you have the rights

- to check whether and what kind of personal data we hold about you and to request copies of such data,
- to request correction, supplementation or deletion of your personal data that is inaccurate or processed in non-compliance with applicable requirements,
- to request us to restrict processing of your personal data
- in certain circumstances, to object for legitimate reasons to the processing of your personal data or to revoke consent previously granted for the processing,

- to request data portability
- to know the identities of third parties to which your personal data are transferred and
- to lodge a complaint with the competent authority.

In case you revoke consent, your revokement will be effective for further data processing, but it will be without prejudice to the processing of your data that we have done before.
